The number of older adults that are surviving into their 80's and 90's, the oldest-old, are the fastest growing segment in the elderly population. Geriatric competence of nurses has been shown to decrease mortality, reduce disability and illness, improve quality of life, and decrease health care costs. Far too few practitioners are available with the specialized knowledge included in geriatrics care. George Mason University's Nurse Practitioner program is helping to solve the shortage, and the Dulles AARP Chapter is helping students with scholarship support to complete their programs.

The School of Nursing at George Mason University is the largest in the Commonwealth of Virginia, graduating over 400 undergraduate and graduate nursing students each year. At the graduate clinical level, the national trend is for nurses to be credentialed as nurse practitioners to meet the primary care need of patients. At Mason, all nurse practitioner students receive educational content in gerontology, in order for them to be able to address the medical needs of older adults in all practice settings.

The Dulles Area chapter of AARP was founded in 1990. Besides raising funds for nursing scholarships, the chapter also makes bag lunches for the Embry Rucker shelter, cleans a section of the W&OD trail, has varied monthly community service projects and has interesting topical speakers at its monthly meetings. DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

From Richmond (95 to Beltway) and the Dulles Toll Road:

From Richmond take 95 North to 495 (Capital Beltway) towards Rockville/Dulles Airport, 495 to Dulles Toll Road, Route 267 West (towards Dulles Airport). Follow toll road to Exit #10 (Herndon). After toll both turn right onto Centreville Road. Go to seventh stop light and make right on Station Street. Go one block and make right onto Lynn street to gate for car show.

From Maryland (Beltway):

Take Beltway (495) to Dulles Toll Road, Route 267 West (Dulles International Airport). Follow toll road to Exit #10 (Herndon). After toll both turn right onto Centreville Road. Go to seventh stop light and make right on Station Street. Go one block and make right onto Lynn Street to gate for car show.

From Fairfax County Parkway (Route 7100):

Take Fairfax county Parkway to Elden Street exit. Go west on Elden Street to Lynn Street, make right on Lynn to car entrance gate. Lynn Street will be first right after light at Monroe Street.
